came from Mr. Herbert Huffman, founder and then director of the Columbus Boychoir School, for the Bryants to joint the music faculty of the Boychoir. They accepted and in 1947 began their work with the Columbus Boychoir.

Two years later, a second son was born, Stephen Lee. Fourteen years have passed and the history of the Columbus Boychoir has been closley related to the talent and skill of Mr. Bryant. In 1956 Mr. Bryant assumed full direction of the musical activities of the Boychoir with the resignation of Mr. Herbert Huffman. Under his brilliant leadership the Columbus Boychoir has achieved notable acclaim in this country and abroad. The Boychoir was the first youth group to represent the United States abroad under former President Eisenhower's Program for Cultural Presentations. The fall of this year added a new laurel to the claim for Mr. Bryant's brilliant direction when the Columbus Boychoir appeared with Leonard Bernstein and the New York Philharmonic for the opening performance at the new Philharmonic Hall in the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts.

The Columbus Boychoir School is fortunate to have found a leader so talented and unselfish as to have given these years of direction and stability to the School.
